SKINNY RUFFLES SHAWLETTE By Linden Heflin

A very simple garter stitch shawl, with an attached ruffled border - so no bound off edge. This is a simple knit, perfect for knitting while watching some TV!

Gauge (garter st, unblocked): 5 sts/in Yarn - Araucania Ranco Multy, 1 skein (376 yds/ 343 m) Needles - US 5 circular, 24" or longer Notions - tapestry needle, stitch marker

Abbreviations: m1 - make 1 by making a firm backward loop (see make 1 away <<u>http://www.knittinghelp.com/videos/</u> increases>)

Set up: CO 3 sts Row 1: k1, YO, pm, k1, YO, k1 Row 2: k all sts

Shawl: RS rows: k1, YO, k to m, m1, slip m, k1, m1, k to 1 st before end, YO, k1 WS rows: k all sts Repeat these two rows 56 times more [233 sts]

Ruffled edging: CO 5 sts

Row 1: k4, k2tog (final st + one st from edge), turn work Row 2: sl 1, k4, turn work Row 3: k5, turn work Row 4: sl 1, k4, turn work

Repeat these 4 rows until you have consumed all sts up to the center st.

Row 1: k5, turn work Row 2: sl 1, k4, turn work Row 3: k k4, k2tog (final st + one st from edge), turn work Row 4: sl 1, k4, turn work Row 5: k5, turn work Row 6: sl 1, k4, turn work

Repeat these 6 rows once more (at this point, you will have consumed the center stitch)

Continue working the previously established ruffled edging pattern (original rows 1-4) until you have consumed all edge stitches. BO the remaining 5 stitches. Block to desired measurements (I blocked pretty aggressively to make the shawl grow!)

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
